



Squash Alberta Restriction Exemption Policy (REP)

In accordance with Government of Alberta Health Measures, effective Monday, September 20th all players, Squash Alberta: Officials, Coaches and Course Facilitators that are 12 years of age and older, will have to provide proof of at least one (1) CoVid -19 vaccination (completed no less than 2 weeks prior to the event) to be permitted to participate in a Squash Alberta Sanctioned Event. This includes all Squash Alberta Sanctioned Tournaments, Interclub Leagues (ESL, CISA, GPSQC, MHSC), Clinics and Courses.

Effective October 25, 2021, proof of full vaccination (two (2) CoVid-19 vaccinations) will be required for participation in Squash Alberta Sanctioned events.

Negative CoVid-19 test results will be accepted for participation in Squash Alberta Sanctioned Events. Tests must be obtained from a private provider and must be completed within 72 hours of "each day" of participation in an event.

Medical exemptions will only be accepted for participation in Squash Alberta Sanctioned events if accompanied by negative CoVid – 19 test results as outlined in the paragraph above.

While the Government of Alberta and AHS finalize electronic means of vaccination proof, a paper copy of the CoVid -19 Client Immunization Record indicating Name, DOB and Date of Immunization in combination with government issued ID will suffice for verification, unless the host facility requires additional documentation.

Only squash facilities that are currently Squash Alberta affiliated clubs in good standing (fees are fully paid) and have a fully implemented Restriction Exemption Program will be eligible to host Squash Alberta Sanctioned Events at this time.

Where the host facility's REP is more restrictive, the host facility's REP must be adhered to.

This CoVid REP is intended as an interim measure. It will be reviewed and updated accordingly, during the course of the worldwide CoVid - 19 pandemic.
